Okavango Delta & Moremi Game Reserve



The Okavango is a unique ecosystem, a river delta located in the middle of the world's largest stretch of continuous sand – the Kalahari basin. An oasis in an otherwise arid and inhospitable landscape, the Okavango Delta supports an incredible diversity of animal and birdlife. Where land and water meet, a mosaic of pans, grasslands, forests and lagoons provides an extremely varied range of habitats which is home to one of Africa's greatest concentrations of wildlife. The Okavango is one of the natural wonders of the world, a still-pristine yet fragile ecosystem that richly rewards exploration.

The Moremi Game Reserve lies in the eastern corner of the Okavango Delta. One of the most beautiful and diverse of all the great game reserves of Africa, it protects both huge concentrations of wildlife and incredible scenery. The reserve consists of both seasonally-inundated areas such as Xakanaxa, and drier areas such as Khwai. On this safari, we will set out to reveal some of the secrets of this dynamic ecosystem.

DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1 & 2

Exclusive Mobile Camp in the Xakanaxa/ 3rd bridge Area of the Moremi Game Reserve & Okavango Delta.

"Dumela / Hello! Welcome to Botswana!"

We will be there to give you a warm Botswana welcome when you land at Maun Airport. We will provide you with a snack pack before you meet your pilot for your stunning light aircraft scenic flight over the Okavango Delta and Chief's Island. This flight gives you a fish eagle's eye view of this amazing ecosystem. When you land at your remote bush airstrip within the Moremi Game Reserve, Brian and your guides will be waiting to transfer you to your mobile camp - with a game drive en route. The friendly, attentive staff will help you feel immediately at home and brief you on what to look forward to on your safari. The magic of a mobile camp becomes apparent as the sun sets and you enjoy drinks around the fire before a starlit dinner and a great night's rest after falling asleep to the sounds of the African bush.

Spending our first two nights in the Xakanaxa / Third Bridge area, we explore the surrounding wilderness on game drives during the day and our evenings with Brian around the campfire.

The Moremi Game Reserve protects around a third of the entire Okavango Delta ecosystem – and is well known for its wild dog sightings and the many lion prides that prowl the area hunting the resident buffalo herds.

TOUR DATE: 8th - 14th November 2018

Day 3, 4 & 5

Exclusive Mobile Camp in Khwai Game Reserve bordering Moremi.

Following an early breakfast, we leave Moremi and continue our journey to Khwai, stopping for a bush picnic lunch en route. The Khwai River forms the boundary between the National Park and the local Khwai Game Reserve. We spend the next three nights at an exclusive camp near the river exploring the Khwai floodplains on day and night game drives. We will also have the opportunity to explore the Delta on a 2½-hour mokoro trip, discovering channels and lagoons at a relaxed pace in a traditional dug-out canoe.

Night drives at Khwai offer a unique opportunity to encounter less well-known nocturnal creatures rarely seen during daylight hours and with luck, we will witness the night time activities of the larger carnivores who set about hunting under the cloak of darkness.

Day 6

Gomoti Plains Luxury Bush Camp

This morning we leave the bush and fly further into the Delta to the beautiful Gomoti Plains Camp. This traditional Botswana lodge sits surrounded by water and the wildlife is prolific. We can spend our afternoon relaxing in sheer luxury watching the myriad bird species and mammals such as hippo and elephant that come to drink nearby or go out in a mokoro for an up close and personal encounter from a water level vantage point.

This evening Brian will treat us all to a Gala Dinner created especially for us as a finale to our unique safari.

With fine wines, delicious food and great company we can spend the evening reliving our adventures before we depart the following day for our flight back to Maun and beyond.
